## Security New Flash

**New headline: [Huntingdon train stab suspect could be linked to string of knife incidents in hours before rampage.](#)**

Passengers expecting to travel on East Coast Main Line services have been warned of continued disruption after Saturday evening's [mass stabbing onboard a train from Doncaster to London](#).

British Transport Police (BTP) have confirmed that [two people remain in a life-threatening condition](#) following the bloody rampage, while two British nationals have been arrested on suspicion of attempted murder.

[LNER](#), which operates most intercity trains on the UK's flagship route, said disruption to its services between London Kings Cross and Yorkshire was likely to last until Monday.

David Horne, managing director of [LNER](#), said "We are deeply shocked and saddened by this serious incident, and our thoughts are very much with everyone involved.

"The safety and wellbeing of everyone affected will remain our priority. We will continue to do everything we can to support our customers and colleagues during this difficult time."

## SIA Licence New

### How to Get Your First SIA Badge

1. **Get First Aid (if DS/SG):** Valid *Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW)* or higher is required before training starts.
2. **Complete an SIA licence-linked course:** DS (6–7 days), SG (4–5 days), or CCTV (3–4 days).
3. **Receive your certificate** from the awarding body.
4. **Apply on GOV.UK:** Create/sign in to your SIA account, complete forms and ID checks, and pay the fee.
5. **Background checks:** The SIA will run criminality (DBS) and right-to-work checks.
6. **Approval & delivery:** You'll get an email decision; the physical badge arrives by post.

### How to Replace a Lost or Stolen Badge

1. **Report immediately** to your employer and site management to avoid compliance issues.
2. **Check SIA account** for the replacement option and follow the instructions.
3. **Police crime reference** may be requested if stolen.
4. **Replacement fee** applies (paid to the SIA ) and a new card is posted to you.

While waiting, keep proof of your **active licence status** (approval email/SIA account screenshot) and follow your employer's policy.
